You will indicate course selections for the 2016-17 school terms on the reverse side of this form. Your registration advisor or the guidance counselor can answer any questions regarding course requirements and prerequisites.

SCHEDULING PROCEDURES

You will be registered in seven (7) courses for a total of seven (7) credits.

Your counselor will review your requests and place you in the appropriate courses according to the following:

1. Required courses for remediation in Reading/Math will be scheduled first.
2. Required academic classes will be scheduled second.
3. Required elective courses will be scheduled third.
4. Requested courses will be scheduled last.

ONCE COURSES HAVE BEEN SELECTED, THE REGISTRATION FORM BECOMES A COMMITMENT TO REMAIN IN THE CHOSEN CLASSES. Every effort will be made to accommodate the selections indicated; however, the following factors may affect the student's final schedule:

- A course offering not requested by a sufficient number of students will be cancelled.
- A course request that conflicts, (i.e. same period) with another course request.
- A final grade does not meet the prerequisite.
- A teacher is not available to teach the course.

Students should be aware that because of conflicts, there might be a need to place them in alternate courses that fit their schedule. If more students request a given course than there are slots available, it will be necessary to assign students to the course on a priority basis (generally seniors who need a given course to graduate will be given first priority).

DUAL ENROLLMENT & ADVANCED PLACEMENT

Students who qualify may substitute dual enrollment or Advanced Placement (AP) for the ones normally offered at the school. If you are interested in any of these programs, please set up an appointment with your guidance counselor to discuss eligibility requirements and enrollment procedures.
